# \$1,000 Grants Available

Grants are available to promote international education in your school. Schools hosting AYA students are eligible to apply for a \$1,000 Tony Cook Memorial grant awarded by the AIFS Foundation to fund a program or event promoting international education and awareness. The Foundation awards between 10 and 15 grants annually. Please contact AYA for an application.
